PUBLIC HEARING #1 – 2011 TAX BUDGET

Budget was discussed for 2011. Total budget of \$6,058,999.00: \$964,000.00 for General Fund, \$1,100,000.00 for Road & Bridge Fund, \$3,016,349.00 for Fire Levy Fund, and \$978,650.00 for Road Levy Fund.

PUBLIC HEARING #2 – ZONING TEXT AMENDMENTS

3. Eliminate the use of term 'occupancy permit'. Recommend changing it to "Certificate of Zoning Compliance".
4. Add Town Hall Commons & Town Hall Neighborhood Districts to the list of Use Districts. Eliminate the "Research & Comprehensive Office (RD-1) District" from the list.
5. Clarify the expiration of plan approval, add term 'final' site plan to eliminate confusion in the approval process, and update flow chart with correct board reference.

CORRESPONDENCE – TRUSTEES:

Mrs. Luhta: No correspondence, but had an incident she would like to tell. Across from the airport there was a small fawn that was limping. Called Lake Metroparks Wildlife Office because I thought they rehabilitate injured animals. They said they no longer are allowed to. The State has mandated that they do not rehabilitate deer, but they would euthanize it if we bring it in. I just wanted the people in Concord Township to know that this is now the policy of the State. Individuals are not allowed to rehabilitate deer either.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

A. FIRE DEPT. – Chief Warner

1) **Fire Act Grant** – Applied for grant for finishing off the traffic preemption systems. Met with Congressman LaTourrette's office to get their support. They will send a letter of support. We'll also send it out to Senators Voinovich & Brown to get their support.

2) **Public Safety Training Center** – Have been having a lot of talks in regards to another firehouse along with a training center at Auburn Career Center. We've applied for a couple of grants & haven't been successful. Maybe that was to our benefit, because now we have formed a partnership with Lakeland College and in the next few days Lakeland College and Auburn Career Center will be making a public announcement they're working together to build a new public safety training center,

B. ADMINISTRATION DEPT. – Jack J. Nettis, Jr., Administrator

1) **Recycling** – Going very well. Suggested residents drop off aluminum cans at the Fire Departments as the money is used for fire prevention & fire education. The paper bins are doing very well also.

2) **Service Dept. Update** – Working very hard. They have completed on their own some major reconstruction projects. Discussed the process of Dura Patching.

- C. **READ BIDS FOR SERVICE DEPT. ROOF REPAIRS & SKYLIGHTS.** Mr. Nettis asked for the item to be tabled. Would like to go over bids further before they are read.
- D. **DECISION ON SERVICE DEPT. ROOF REPAIRS & SKYLIGHTS BID.** Mr. Galloway stated they are not going to vote on.
- E. **DECISION ON PUBLIC HEARING: RESOLUTION 2010-10 / APPROVE 2011 TAX BUDGET.** Mr. Malchesky moved to adopt the following Resolution, as was presented earlier at the Public Hearing:

RESOLUTION 2010-10***Resolution to Approve the 2011 Tax Budget***

WHEREAS, the 2011 Concord Township Tax Budget must be adopted by the Concord Township Board of Trustees on or before July 15, 2010, and

WHEREAS, two copies must be submitted to the Lake County Auditor on or before July 20, 2010,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the 2011 Concord Township Budget for funds requesting general tax revenue has been adopted.

Mrs. Luhta seconded. Vote: 3 ayes.

- F. **PUBLIC HEARING DECISION: ZONING TEXT AMENDMENTS.**
Amendment #1 – Section IV, Penalty: Update the fine for violations, as specified in the Ohio Revised Code Section 519.99.

Mr. Malchesky moved to adopt Amendment #1 - Section IV, Penalty, as proposed by the Zoning Commission. Mrs. Luhta seconded. Vote: 3 ayes.

Amendment #2 – Section X, Zoning Inspector:

- a. Expand and clarify the responsibilities of the Zoning Inspector.
- b. Clarify when the Zoning Inspector is authorized to make inspections on properties for the purpose of enforcing the Zoning Resolution.

Mr. Malchesky moved to adopt Amendment #2 – Section X, Zoning Inspector, as proposed by the Zoning Commission. Mrs. Luhta seconded. Vote: 3 ayes.

Amendment #3 – Section XXII, Occupancy Permit:

- a. Eliminate the use of the term "occupancy permit". Originally created in 1979 as a "use certificate" to verify that any proposed use or structure, upon inspection, conformed to the approved plan upon which a zoning permit was issued. Resolution 79-3 initiated by the Trustees in 1979 instructed the Zoning Commission to create such "use certificates". The name was changed to "occupancy permit" in 1982.
- b. Current practice of the zoning office is to inspect all proposed uses/structures to verify conformance with the approved plans and zoning permit. If in conformance, a "Certificate of Zoning Compliance" is issued (certificate approved by the Trustees in Feb. 2004). Eliminate the use of the term "occupancy permit" in the text, as it creates confusion with the occupancy permit issued by the Lake County Building Department. Recommend changing it in the text to "Certificate of Zoning Compliance".

Mr. Malchesky moved to adopt Amendment #3 – Section XIV, Use Districts, as proposed by the Zoning Commission. Mrs. Luhta seconded. Vote: 3 ayes.

- **Amendment #4 – Section XIV Use Districts:**

- a. Add Town Hall Commons (THC) and Town Hall Neighborhood (THN) Districts to the list of Use Districts, which were added to the text on June 19, 2009.
- b. Eliminate the "Research and Comprehensive Office (RD-1) District" from the list, which was repealed on June 19, 2009.

Mr. Malchesky moved to adopt Amendment #4 – Section XIV, Use Districts, as proposed by the Zoning Commission. Mrs. Luhta seconded. Vote: 3 ayes.

- **Amendment #5 – Section XXXVI Site Plan Review:**

- a. Revise Section 36.06 E, Zoning Commission Action, to clarify the expiration of plan approval. No expiration period is currently in place from the time a plan is

- "conditionally approved" by the commission or board, to the time a final plan is submitted for a Zoning Permit.
- b. Add the term "final" site plan in this section, where noted, to eliminate confusion in the approval process.
 - c. Update flow chart with correct board reference (BZA not Zoning Commission).

Mr. Malchesky moved to adopt Amendment #5 – Section XXXVI, Use Districts, as proposed by the Zoning Commission. Mrs. Luhta seconded. Vote: 3 ayes.

- G. FIRE DEPT. CONTRACT. Mr. Malchesky moved to adopt the Fire Dept. Contract/Agreement between Concord Township and the International Association of Professional Firefighters, Local 3329, effective 1-1-10 through 12-31-12. Mrs. Luhta seconded.

Discussion: Mr. Malchesky felt going through fact finding gives you everyone's perspective. It forces both parties to listen to individual and parties' issues & concerns. It makes for a better Fire Dept. and better Township.

Chief Warner agreed. Having a third party sometimes looks at things and gives everybody a clean view and makes it easier for us to move forward. It was a good experience.

Mr. Malchesky: You have more review of your budgets. Goals & budgets are related & compared to both the Fire Dept. & Township.

Roll Call Vote: Mr. Galloway – yes; Mrs. Luhta – yes; Mr. Malchesky – yes.

- H. SERVICE DEPT. - CHANGE ORDER: VIEWMOUNT DRIVE REPLACEMENT PROJECT. Mr. Nettis stated the repairs became more complicated. The Lake County Engineer's office worked very closely with the contractor & us in trying to contain costs and still the same quality of work we wanted. In the end the County felt it was fair and appropriate to approve \$868,43.

Mrs. Luhta moved to approve the Change Order for an additional \$863,43 for the Viewmount Drive replacement Project. Mr. Malchesky seconded. Vote: 3 ayes.

- I. OPWC APPROVAL FOR RADCLIFFE (\$30K) AND FAIRFIELD (\$15K) ROADS. Mr. Galloway said we should vote on these individually,

Mr. Nettis explained: Each year we have an opportunity for grants and in the past we have shared in grants. We were asked to participate in 2 joint grants, one being with the Geauga County Engineer's through Hambden Township and ourselves doing Radcliffe Road. Our portion of that cost to us after the grant, should we receive it, would be \$30,000.00. We would be asking the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for this amount.

Mr. Malchesky moved to approve OPWC grant application of \$30,000.00 for **Radcliffe Road**. Mrs. Luhta seconded. Vote: 3 ayes.

Mr. Nettis: Regarding Fairfield, Fairfield is a road we share the end of with Painesville Township. Likewise they are putting in for an OPWC project. They asked us if we would like to join in on that project and we would need to consider the vote on this for \$15,000.00 for our end of the project.

Mr. Malchesky moved to approve OPWC grant application of \$15,000.00 for **Fairfield Road**. Mrs. Luhta seconded. Vote: 3 ayes.
